3'6"-3'9", with 4' Options. Two-round classic. Open to all. Riders limited to four (4) horses in this class. Horses are not required to show in any other class at the show. Horses must be on grounds 24 hours prior to start of the class. The same horse may not compete in the USHJA International Hunter Derby and the National Hunter Derby at the same competition. Horses entered in this class are not required to show in any other hunter or jumper classes at the horse show. Riders are limited to competing no more than four (4) horses in each class. All horses entered in the International Hunter Derby class must jog for soundness during the Official Jog prior to the start of the first round in order to compete.

Stabling/Schooling:All horses competing in the Derby class must be on the competition grounds a minimum of 24 hours prior to the start of the first round of the class. All horses will be monitored and must remain on the competition grounds until the horse is finished competing in the Derby class. Any horse that leaves the premises prior to completing its participation in the Derby class is disqualified. All horses must be ridden in official horse show schooling areas. Riders must wear the horses' competition number while mounted.

Course Requirements: Fence height 3'6"-4', with at least four option fences 4'3" or higher per round. A minimum of ten obstacles for the first round and a minimum of eight obstacles for remaining rounds. Obstacles will simulate those reminiscent of the hunt field and course will offer a variety of Classic jumps with different appearances.

Judging:.....Two panels of two judges.

Round 1The Classic Hunter Style Round shall be judged and numerically scored on quality, movement, jumping style, manners and way of going. Pace and brilliance will be rewarded. In addition to this base score, each judging panel shall award an Option Bonus Score consisting of one additional point for every higher height option fence jumped. These two scores will be added together to determine each horse-and-rider combination's score for this round from each judging panel. The scores of all the judging panels will be added together to determine the total score of each horse-and-rider combination for this round.

Round 2:The Handy Hunter Round shall be judged and numerically scored on quality, movement, jumping style, manners and way of going. Pace and brilliance will be rewarded. Jumping decorations to utilize a shorter track is NOT permissible. In addition to this base score, each judging panel must award an Option Bonus Score consisting of one additional point for every higher height option fence jumped and each judging panel must award a Handy Bonus Score consisting of between zero and 10 bonus points to each horse-and-rider combination for handiness of round. Jump-Off Round:... If required, the jump-off round shall be judged and numerically scored on quality, movement, jumping style, manners and way of going. Pace and brilliance will be rewarded. Jumping decorations to utilize a shorter track is NOT permissible. In addition to this base score, each judging panel must award an Option Bonus Score consisting of one additional point for every higher height option fence jumped and each judging panel must award a Handy Bonus Score consisting of between zero and 10 bonus points to each horse-and- rider combination for handiness of round. Schooling During the two rounds of the National Hunter Derby, all horses entered must be ridden in official horse show schooling areas. Riders must wear their horse's Derby competition number while mounted.

Course Requirements: . Fence height 3'0" with four option fences set at 3'5" per round. Obstacles will simulate those reminiscent of the hunt field and course will offer a variety of Classic jumps with different appearances.

Round 1: Classic Hunter Style Course: a minimum of ten obstacles will be offered in the Classic Hunter Round, including at least one in and out, at least one bending line, at least one line with an unrelated distance, and at least one long approach.

Round 2: Handy Hunter Course: a minimum of eight obstacles will be offered in the Handy Hunter Round. The course will simulate riding over hunt country and will have a minimum of two handy options. Only the top 12 horses from the first round, after all ties are broken, are eligible to return for the second round.

Judging: One panel of two judges.

Round 1: The first round shall be judged on performance, hunter pace, jumping style, quality and substance, and movement. After the judges base score is given, one point will be added for each high option fence jumped (Maximum of four points).

Round 2: The second round shall be judged on performance, hunter pace, jumping style, quality and substance, movement, handiness and brilliance of pace. Handiness is taken into account in the judges' base score. After the judges' base score is given, one point will be added for each high option fence jumped (Maximum of four points).

Overall Score: The final score from each round (3'0" with 3'5" options) will be added together to obtain the overall total for each horse.

Course Requirements: Fence height 2'6 with four 2'9 option fences per round. Obstacles will simulate those reminiscent of the hunt field and course will offer a variety of Classic jumps with different appearances.

Round 1: The first round shall be judged on performance, hunter pace, jumping style, quality and substance, and movement. After the judge(s) base score is given, one (1) point will be added for each high option fence jumped. The Option Bonus Score of one additional point must be awarded even if there is a refusal, rail down or loss of good jumping style at that higher height option fence, providing that the horse-and-rider combination does jump the higher height option fence. (Maximum of four points.)

Round 2: The second round shall be judged on performance, hunter pace, jumping style, quality and substance, movement, handiness and brilliance of pace. Handiness is defined as ground saving movement without adversely affecting performance or style. Brilliance of pace is defined as a faster pace than ordinary, without sacrificing performance or style. Handiness is taken into account in the judges' base score. After the judge(s)' base score is given, one (1) point will be added for each high option fence jumped. The Option Bonus Score of one additional point must be awarded even if there is a refusal, rail down or loss of good jumping style at that higher height option fence, providing that the horse-and-rider combination does jump the higher height option fence. (Maximum of four points.)

Overall Score: The final score from each round will be added to obtain the overall total for each horse.

- Horse Inspection.....
1. Championship horses must be stabled on the show grounds, in official horse show stabling starting no later than two hours prior to the horse inspection and remaining on the show grounds until the completion of their championship. (Minus extenuating circumstances)
 2. Horses competing in the championship may not compete in any other class at the same horse show after the Official horse inspection has taken place. Exception: Official 1.00/1.05m USHJA Championship Training class.
 3. All championship horses must be presented at the mandatory horse inspection by the athlete or a designated representative. The horse inspection will be held not more than 24 hours prior to the start of the First Individual Qualifying Class.
 4. If the athlete is unable to attend the horse inspection, a designated representative who is 18 years of age or older may present and jog the horse.
 5. Each horse must be presented with its entry number and a current negative Coggins test, passport, or USEF proof of horse registration. Following the official horse inspection, the assigned back number must always accompany the horse when it is out of its stall and must be visible on the stall door otherwise.
 6. Horses not accepted at the horse inspection will have the opportunity to be re-presented once prior to the First Individual Qualifying Class.
 7. If a horse is not accepted at the initial horse inspection, the horse may not participate in the Championship Training session if it is held prior to the re-inspection. Horses not accepted at the re-inspection will not be allowed to compete in the championships nor may they participate in any concurrently held competition during which the championship is held on the same grounds for a period of 48 hours following the horse inspection. (GR914.3)
- Prize Money:..... 60% of the overall prize money offered will be allocated to the team competition as follows: 50% - Gold, 30% - Silver, 20% - Bronze. 40% of the overall prize money offered will be paid to the winning individuals as follows: 30%, 22%, 15%, 10%, 7%, 6%, 5%, 5%.
- Tack/ Equipment:.....

Athlete Rules

Horse Inspection

and jog for soundness: ...This involves a formal inspection of the horse using an official identification document and includes jog for soundness.

1. ZJTC horses must be stabled on the show grounds, in official horse show stabling beginning no later than one hour prior to the horse inspection and remaining on the grounds until the completion of the ZJTC.
2. Horses competing in the ZJTC may not compete in any other class at the same horse show after the official horse inspection has taken place. Exception: ZJTC Training class, if offered.
3. All ZJTC horses must be presented at the mandatory horse inspection by the athlete or designated representative. The horse inspection will be held no more than 24 hours prior to the start of the First Individual Qualifying Class. The exact time and location will be included in the prize list and schedule for each ZJTC.
4. A designated representative other than the rider, who must be at least 18 years of age, may present the horse at the horse inspection.
 - a. Each horse must be presented with its entry number and current Coggins and or passport (USEF proof of horse registration). Following the horse inspection, the assigned back number must always accompany the horse when it is out of its stall and must be visible on the stall door when in the stall.
 - b. Horses not accepted at the horse inspection will have the opportunity to be represented once, prior to the First Individual Qualifying Class.
 - c. If a horse is not accepted at the initial horse inspection the horse may not participate in the ZJTC Training Session if it is held prior to the re-inspection. Horses not accepted at the re-inspection will not compete in the ZJTC. Horses may not participate in any concurrently held competition during which the ZJTC is held 48 hours following the horse inspection. (GR914.3)

Prize Money: Day 1: 20% of the sections overall prize money will be paid through 8th as follows: 30%, 22%, 15%, 10%, 7%, 6%, 5%, 5%; Day 2: 15% of the section's overall prize money will be paid to the Gold, Silver, and Bronze winning teams. Prize money will be paid through 3rd as follows: 50%, 30%, 20% and divided equally among the team's members. Additionally, ribbons will be awarded through 8th to the individual class placings after round one and round two of the Team Competition. 5. The draw for the Team Order of Go will take place at the Riders' Meeting.
6. Teams will be determined two weeks prior to the ZJTC and are subject to change should a member of a team scratch. All necessary changes will be communicated to the Zone Chefs d'Equipe.

Attire (JP 111.9)1. Official Horse Inspection and Course Walks

- a. Athletes and or designated representatives must be appropriately dressed. Athletes must wear boots, breeches, and a helmet. A designated representative must be professionally dressed and wearing a helmet and proper footwear for the Official Horse Inspection. Please refer to USEF rule JP 111.9c.
2. First Individual Qualifier and Team Competition
 - a. White breeches: and zone team shirts are encouraged. Shirts must have collars and sleeves (sleeves may be long or short) and must be tucked into breeches. Sleeveless shirts and shirts with exposed hoods are prohibited. If team shirts are not available, athletes must follow the Formal Attire dress code. (JP 111.9a)
 - b. All athletes on each team must all wear coordinated shirts or Otherwise, athletes must wear formal attire. Boots are required, and half chaps are permitted providing the color matches the paddock boot.
3. Individual Final
 - a. Formal Attire required. (JP111.9a)
