*Description: To be held in the Grand Prix Ring. One equitation horse/rider combination teamed with one jumper horse/rider combination. (One professional maximum per team). Duplicate courses to be set at 1.00m and 1.20m. Team members each have a choice about what height to jump, but height must be consistent from start to finish for each competitor. Equitation entries that choose to jump 1.20 will get a +3 bonus on score. Jumpers that choose to jump 1.00m will get a +2 second addition to their time. Jumper time to be deducted from equitation score. Equitation entries will receive -4 points for any rail or refusal. Jumper entries will receive a +2 second addition to their time for each rail down. Placings will be determined from highest to lowest score after deduction. Money won by equitation teammate will be awarded to trainer if rider is a Junior or Amateur.*

*Description: In this competition, instead of being eliminated at the first fault, the rider gets two points for an obstacle correctly jumped and one point for an obstacle knocked down. This competition takes place with a fixed time of 60 to 90 seconds. Refusals are penalized by the time lost by the rider, but two disobediences or a fall incurs elimination of the rider. The winner of the competition will be the rider who, at the end of the fixed time, has acquired the greatest number of points in the fastest time. When the fixed time is reached, the bell is rung. The rider must then jump the next obstacle and the clock is stopped at the moment when the horse's forefeet reach the ground, but he is given no points for the obstacle jumped after the bell has rung. If the fixed time is reached at the moment when the Horse is already taking off, this obstacle, whether it is knocked down or not, counts. The Athlete's time is taken at the next obstacle. When the Athlete does not jump at the first attempt the obstacle at which the clock should be stopped, the round is ended. The Athlete is then placed last of those who have obtained the same number of points.*

*Description: This class will consist of two rounds. The first round will be a jumper equitation style course. The second round will be an equitation style course to include different and creative gymnastic exercises. A third round work off or flat phase, if needed, will be at the judges discretion. Fences to be set at 3'3. The class is open to all professional, junior or amateur riders. The same horse must be used in both phases. Only one entry per rider. Money won by Juniors or Amateurs will be awarded to the trainer.*

*Description: Five verticals will be set two strides apart. First round will be set 1.20-1.40m. Each horse and rider combination that successfully jumps the five verticals will continue on to the jump off. The height of the verticals will be heightened for each jump off.*

Horses entered in these classes will NOT be required to jog for soundness.

Schooling.....During the two rounds of the National Hunter Derby, all horses entered must be ridden in official horse show schooling areas. Riders must wear their horse's Derby competition number while mounted.

Course Requirements: ....Fence height 3'0" with four option fences set at 3'5" per round. Obstacles will simulate those reminiscent of the hunt field and course will offer a variety of Classic jumps with different appearances.

Round 1: .....Classic Hunter Style Course: a minimum of ten obstacles will be offered in the Classic Hunter Round, including at least one in and out, at least one bending line, at least one line with an unrelated distance, and at least one long approach.

Round 2: .....Handy Hunter Course: a minimum of eight obstacles will be offered in the Handy Hunter Round. The course will simulate riding over hunt country and will have a minimum of two handy options. Only the top 12 horses from the first round, after all ties are broken, are eligible to return for the second round.

Judging: .....One panel of two judges.

Round 1: .....The first round shall be judged on performance, hunter pace, jumping style, quality and substance, and movement. After the judges base score is given, one point will be added for each high option fence jumped (Maximum of four points).

Round 2: .....The second round shall be judged on performance, hunter pace, jumping style, quality and substance, movement, handiness and brilliance of pace. Handiness is taken into account in the judges' base score. After the judges' base score is given, one point will be added for each high option fence jumped (Maximum of four points).

Overall Score:.....The final score from each round (3'0" with 3'5" options) will be added together to obtain the overall total for each horse.

Course will be set with creative elements; for example a walk jump, bounces, etc. Jumps are to mimic those found in a hunt field. The Handy Hunter Challenge shall be judged and numerically scored on quality, movement, jumping style, handiness, manners and way of going. Pace and brilliance are to be rewarded with extreme speed to be penalized.*
